Benefits of keeping green pallets in the LOOP

Put money back into your business

Return green LOOP pallets and earn £2-£4 per pallet. For higher-volume branches, those returns can add up to thousands of pounds in credits each year.

Reduce your carbon footprint

Every pallet returned can be inspected, repaired and reused, helping keep timber in circulation for longer and reducing the need for new pallets to be manufactured.

Keep your yard tidier and safer

Loose pallets can quickly become a hazard. A simple, organised pallet area helps keep yards clear, reduces the risk of damage and makes collections easier to manage.

Support a stronger supply chain

LOOP pallets are designed to move through the construction supply chain and return for reuse. Keeping them moving helps support reliable pallet availability for manufacturers, merchants and customers.

Green LOOP pallets are valuable assets, not storage platforms.

Returning them helps your business earn money back, reduce waste and keep timber in use for longer. Every pallet left sitting in a yard is missed value, so keeping them moving is one of the simplest ways your branch can make a difference.

Per pallet – damaged but repairable

Dirty or minor damage still earns £2
each – don't discard them.

Information on our collection service

What is The Pallet LOOP?

The Pallet LOOP is the UK's first circular economy pallet reuse scheme designed for the construction industry.

Our service makes it simple to recover, repair and reuse pallets - cutting waste and costs while helping the environment. We aim to collect all types of pallets in around three working days, where possible.

By returning our distinctive green LOOP pallets, you'll also earn **£2 to £4** back per pallet.

What we collect

We accept green LOOP pallets, as well as branded or unbranded white pallets (including plasterboard pallets). As long as pallets are safe to stack and load, we'll take them. See examples below of accepted pallets.



Not accepted: waste timber or pallets that are destroyed, contaminated, unsafe, or beyond economical repair.

How it works

Request a collection

- Call us on **0800 024 6130** (8am–5pm), email collections@thepalletloop.com or visit www.thepalletloop.com.
- Provide your site details, purchase order number, and the number of pallets.

Costs & credits

- **£2** credit for every green pallet that is damaged or dirty but repairable.
- **£4** credit for every green pallet that is in good condition.
- **£2** charge per white pallet collected (no charge for the collection of green LOOP pallets).
- **£100** charge for collections of under 50 pallets
- **NO** charge for collections of 50 or more pallets

Prepare your pallets

- Stack neatly by size, max 2.4m high (around 15 pallets).
- Use a forklift or telehandler if available; otherwise, let us know so we can bring the right vehicle.
- One hour is included for loading; extra time is charged at **£75/hour**.
